(1st Reading: Amos 7:12-15; Psalm 84; 2nd Reading: Ephesians 1:3-14; Gospel: Mark 6:7-13)

The sending of the Twelve in pairs shows that Jesus intends the mission to be accomplished in synergy and cooperation. None of the participants in the mission, no matter how capable and efficient, is supposed to work in isolation and without linking up with others. Success will have to be the result of common effort, with no one claiming credit for oneself.

Mission, therefore becomes the context for formation in humility and charity, which are necessary dispositions for working harmoniously and witnessing to the world that the message being announced is the message of God. Unity in diversity will be the most convincing proof that the missionaries are God-sent. Proceeding in pairs will also be a training in being keepers and stewards of one another, channels of God's care and concern for the safety of each one of them.






WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR GRANDPARENTS
